**Abstrac:** How big software companies manage complexity: A walk-through of the practices, design decisions and day-to-day tasks behind the development, maintenance, collaboration and shipment of a software project at Google.

**Short Bio, David García:** David holds a MSc in Computer Science from the University of Oviedo. From 2006-2010 he was a member of the Beams and Controls group at CERN (European Organization for Nuclear Research, Geneva, Switzerland), responsible for the software and instrumentation of the Large Hadron Collider particle accelerator. From 2010-2012 he worked in the Advanced Technologies group at the Lawrence Berkeley National Lab (Berkeley, California) on the software for the Advanced Light Source synchrotron. David joined Google in 2012, where he became Senior Software Engineer, having worked on Google's data processing pipelines for advertisement, NLP as part of Google Research's AI group and on Google Infrastructure's new network protocol, gRPC.
